

# Declaration of Compliance



With the Suppliers of Smart Meters Code of Conduct (2012)

Regarding data from low-volume meters that can be read remotely.

**Names of legal entities:** Eneco Consumenten B.V. and Eneco Zakelijk B.V., hereafter jointly referred to as Eneco, and Oxxio Nederland B.V. and CEN B.V., hereafter jointly referred to as Oxxio.

Eneco and Oxxio make use of meter data obtained from low-volume meters that can be read remotely in order to carry out their services properly. As a supplement to the Dutch Personal Data Protection Act (now the General Data Protection Regulation), suppliers and meter reading companies acting under their responsibility in the Dutch energy sector have drawn up a Code of Conduct regarding the use, recording, exchange and storage of data obtained from low-volume meters that can be read remotely (the Suppliers of Smart Meters Code of Conduct).

(Selina) Thurer, in its capacity as director of Eneco Consumenten Nederland B.V., which in turn is a director of Eneco Consumenten B.V., Oxxio Nederland B.V. and CEN B.V., and in its capacity as director of Eneco Zakelijk Nederland B.V., which in turn is a director of Eneco Zakelijk B.V., hereby declares that during the period stated below Eneco and Oxxio complied with the rules and obligations described in the Suppliers of Smart Meters Code of Conduct.
